

Bharat Darshan

- i. **Group-A** (South Group) consisting of 27 OTs visited Madurai, Rameshwaram Dhansukhodi, Kanyakumari, Thiruvananthapuram, Kochi, Alappuzha, Munnar, Athirappally Waterfalls, Coimbatore, Ooty, and Mysore.
- ii. **Group-B** (North and East Group) consisting of 30 OTs visited Kolkata, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Gangtok, Darjeeling, Bhuvaneshwar and Puri.

During Bharat Darshan different Industry visits were also planned at different locations. South Group visited the Tea Factory at Munnar and North & East Group visited the Tea factory at Darjeeling. This helped OTs to familiarise with the different Industries. The OTs also visited the Income Tax offices at Kochi and Kolkata and interacted with the senior officers posted in these places.
